The Governing Board plays a vital role in school governance. It includes elected parents, teachers, support staff, and the principal. The Governing Board holds certain decision-making powers and approves the school's success and strategic plan, the anti-bullying and anti-violence plan, and other school policies.

The Quebec Education Act mandates that parents are elected to a two year term on the Governing Board.

The Governing Boards will hold virtual joint meetings on Wednesdays: October 14, November 18, December 16, January 13, February 17, March 17, April 14, May 12, and June TBD.

We are seeking TWO parents for the Hadley Junior High School Governing Board.

We are seeking FIVE parents for the Philemon Wright High School Governing Board.

Of the elected parents to the two Governing Boards, we will also be seeking members for the Parents Committee. Parents Committee is an advisory committee to the Western Quebec School Board. It meets once per month.

Its main responsibilities are:

- To promote the participation of parents in School Board activities and committees;
- To advise the School Board on any matter the latter is required to submit to it;
- To advise the School Board on any matter conducive to the most efficient operation possible and;
- To inform the School Board as to the needs identified by the parent representatives.

We are also seeking volunteers for the Special Education Advisory Committee. Any parent of a student with an Independent Education Plan can submit his/her name at the General Assembly. The Governing Boards will submit these names to the Parent Committee.
